# Instructions to use MapPlace on Google Chrome or Firefox with "IE Tab" extension

This document describes the steps to install and setup Google Chrome or Firefox to use MapPlace web services. This is a solution to view MapPlace maps on an IE Tab for Google Chrome or Firefox, for users who have had difficulty with certain functions on MapPlace that no longer work with Internet Explorer 10.

#### Prerequisite:

The MapGuide 6.5 viewer for Internet Explorer must be installed. If not, download and install it from here: http://download.autodesk.com/esd/mapguide/SP1/ENG/MgControl6.5SP1.exe

- Step 1 **Download and install Google Chrome or Firefox.**
- Step 2 **Download and install IE Tab for Google Chrome or Firefox from the following site:** <a href="http://www.ietab.net/">http://www.ietab.net/</a>

Alternately, IE Tab can be installed by the following steps for Firefox:

Click "+ Add to Firefox" to add IE Tab V2 from the following URL:


